Volunteer Opportunities Weeks Before the Festival

- **Ticket sales and office work at the SYRCL office the 2 weeks prior to the festival:** Help sell tickets and complete preparations for the festival at the SYRCL office, January 3-7, 9-12 from 1-5pm.
- **Office Assistance in December:** help us complete preparations for the festival at the SYRCL office December 19-23, 26-30 from 1-5pm.

Thursday, January 12th Volunteer Opportunities

- **General Set-up (morning or afternoon):** Setting up chairs at all the venues, hanging signs and other miscellaneous items ready at all the venues.
- **Miners Foundry Kitchen Help (afternoon):** Unload the food from the trucks, help set up and clean up the pre-festival kick-off party.
