Nevada City.**

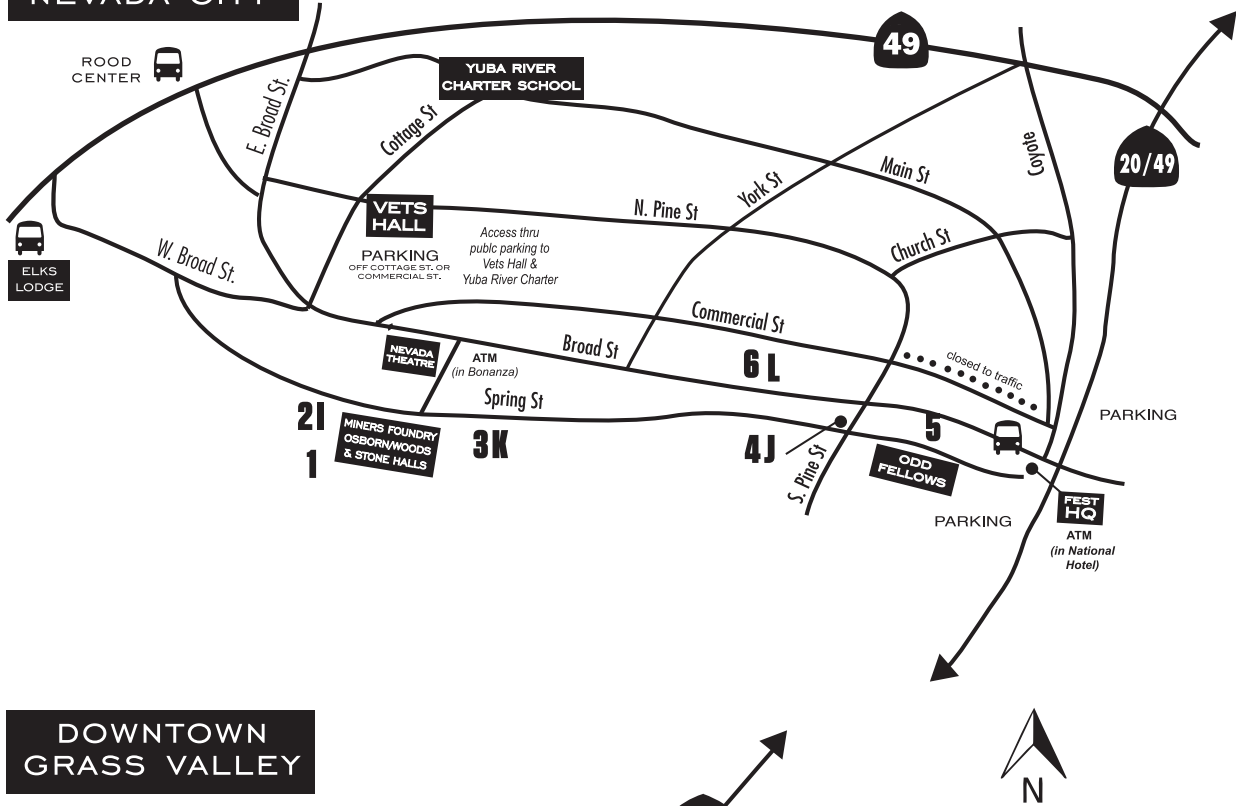

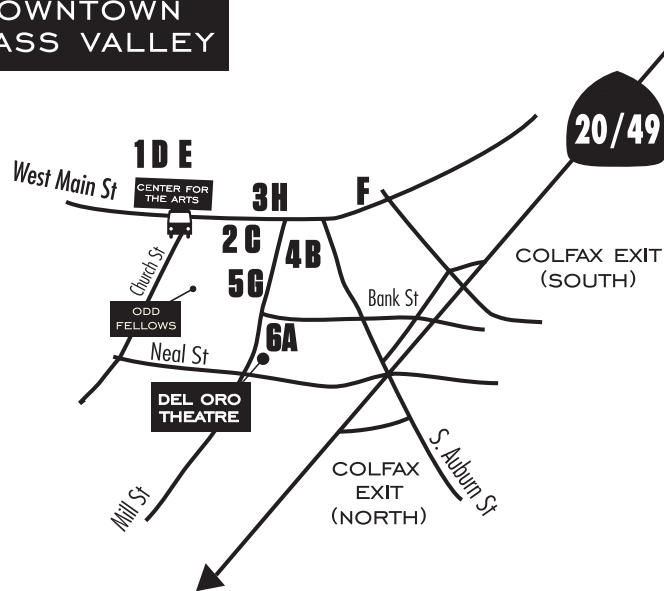
